sights, museums, monuments and




High quality education:

**During break time:** up to 38 hours per week.


# Number of foreign students in Cyprus by country of citizenship 2011 - 2012















- Students in Nicosia can choose from a variety of very affordable housing options.








functional area within a hospitality organization.




### Duration: 1 year
