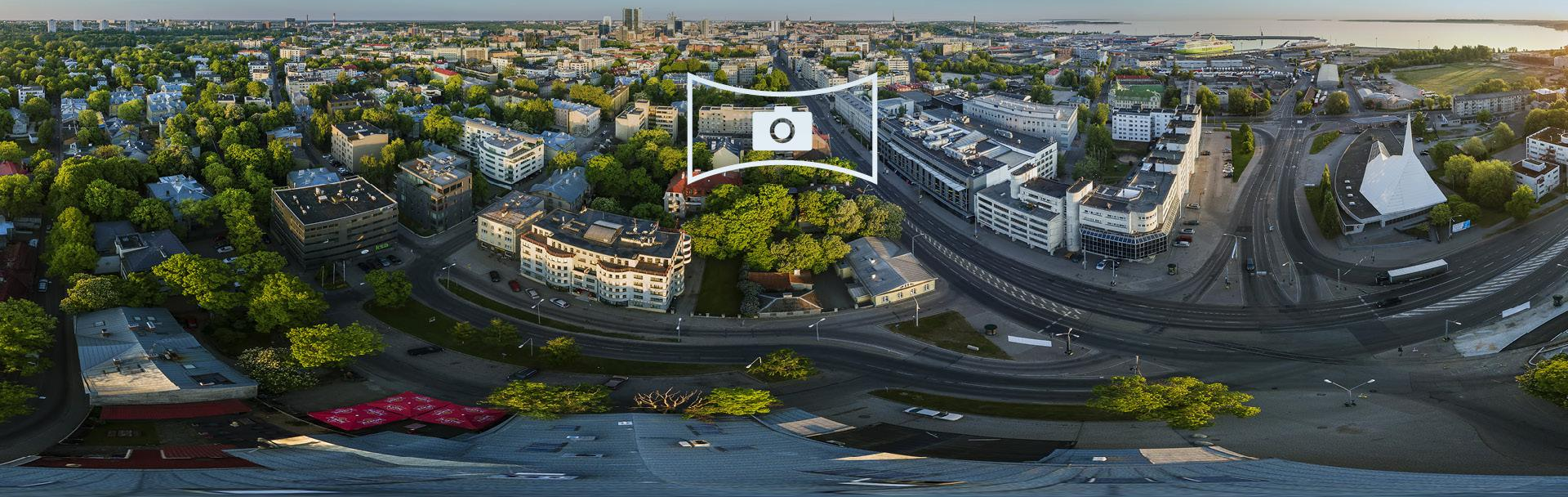

 - Copy of a secondary education certificate / Bachelor's degree certificate / Master's degree certificate and transcript of records
 - The application fee (80 EUR)
 - Proof of English Proficiency
 - Programme specific requirements – entrance exams

- C1 Advanced: 162

- TOEFL paper version: 543, internet based: 72

- PTE academic: 51

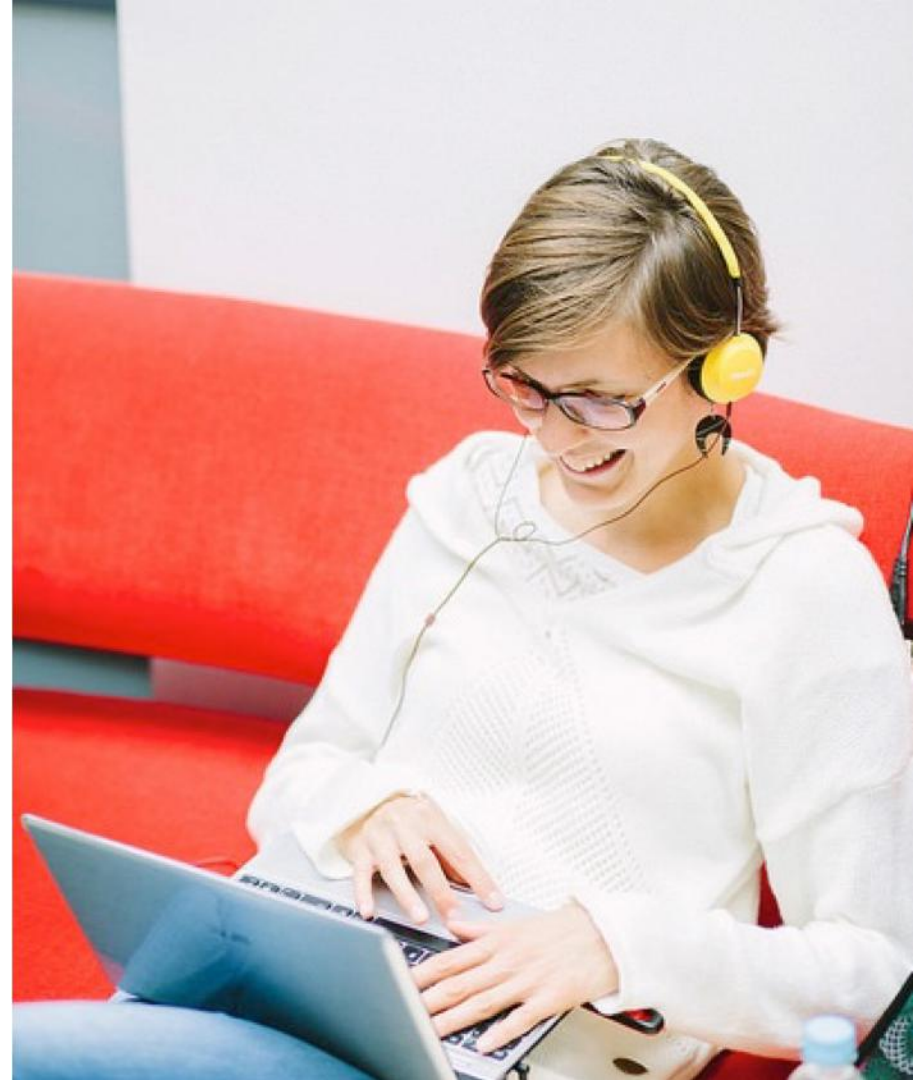
**These general requirements apply to all English-based degree programmes except for the PhD programmes in History, Linguistics and Studies of Cultures that require C1 level of English.*
