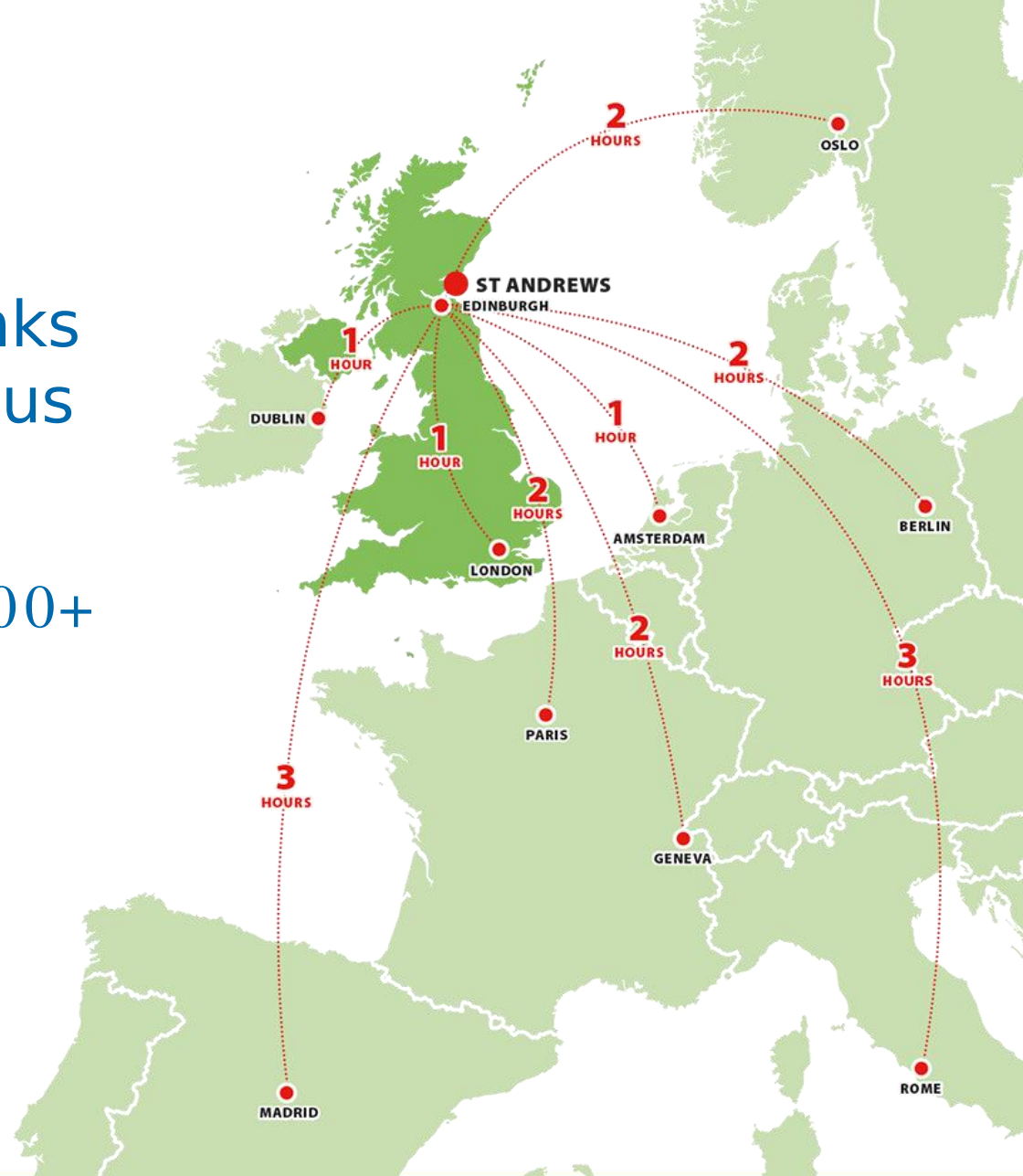

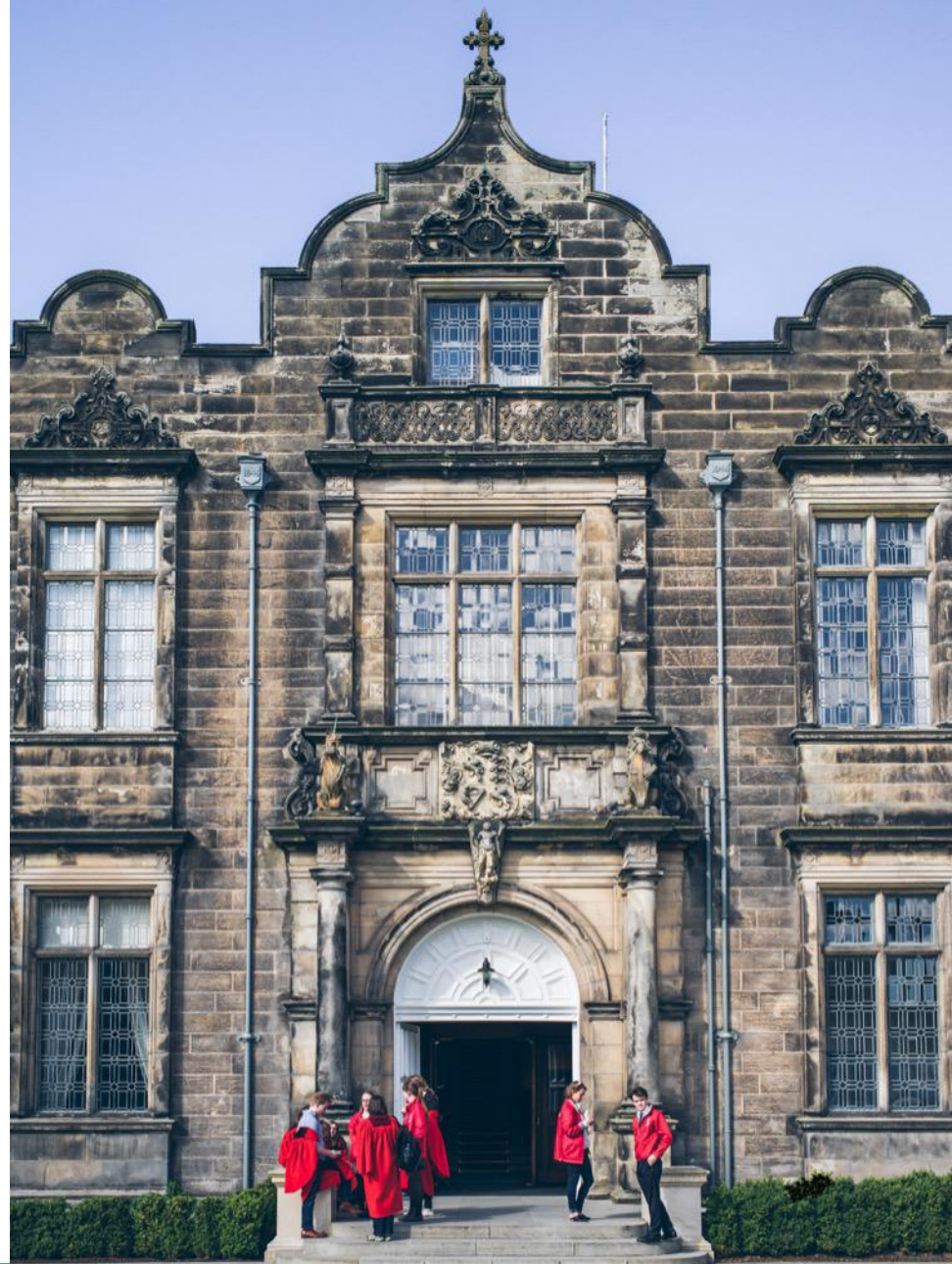

Teaching

St Andrews works on a system of larger lectures, smaller tutorials and lab work, offering access to leading academics.

- 12:1 student-staff ratio
- Between 12 and 24 hours class time per week



Teaching

Focus on independent learning, with access to support from academics

- Independent study and group work out of class time
- Mixture of continuous assessment and exams

Three options for international students - we have no preference

- UCAS
- Common Application
- Direct application



How do I apply?

St Andrews is highly competitive - apply early

- We have rolling admission
- Subjects do fill up before the application deadlines
- Decision time varies depending on the time of year and the subject(s) you apply for



Use of contextual data

The grades listed are likely grades to be considered for an offer, but many factors are taken into consideration when making offers, including context of your grades, your personal statement and references.

What do we look for?

An application needs to show that you are a high academic achiever with a passion for your subject

- Academic qualifications (obtained or predicted)
- Academic reference
- Personal Statement
 - Passion for the subject
 - Personal experience
 - Extra curricular activities



Entry requirements: India

- Indian School Certificate, Intermediate Certificate, Higher School Certificate, Higher Secondary Certificate, All India Senior School Certificate and Pre-University course (awarded on completion of Standard XII)
 - Minimum average of 90% (with 90% or higher in any prerequisite subjects) in Standard XII examinations.
 - A1-A2 if you are taking examinations used by Central Boards.
- A-levels – AAB to A*A*A
- IB requirements range from 36 (HL 6, 6, 5) to 38 (HL 6,6,6 plus SL 6,6,6 plus SL 6,6,6).
- Must meet both the subject-specific and Faculty entry requirements

Degree options

Taught degrees (MLitt, MSc, MRes)

- More than 100 degree options
- Mostly specialisation of undergraduate degree
- Interdisciplinary degrees (Graduate School)
- Typically one full calendar year

Research degrees (PhD, MPhil, MSt/MSc by research)

- Research opportunities within wide range of disciplines
- PhDs typically last 3 to 4 years
- Teaching opportunities

How do I apply?

Direct application to St Andrews

- Rolling admissions
- Application deadlines for specific programmes
- Research applicants must contact potential supervisor before applying
- Decision time varies



How do I apply?

- University transcripts and degree certificate(s)
- Two academic references
- CV
- Proof of English language proficiency*
- Writing sample*
- Personal statement*
- Research proposal (research degrees only)
