


Tartu Student capital of Estonia

Business Administration

Covers all areas of business administration: business law, management, economic policy, accounting, finance, marketing, ethics, human resources, global economy, innovation and research methods.

- **Duration**: 3 years
- **Entry criteria**: 60% state exam result/final grade in Mathematics, 40% score of the motivation letter
- Tuition fee: 3800 EUR / year
- Tuition-waiver scholarships available

Science and Technology

Broad education in natural science. Specializations: Genetics and Biotechnology; Bioengineering and Robotics; Chemistry and Materials Science.

- **Duration**: 3 years
- **Entry criteria**: 40% state exam result/final grade in Mathematics; 40 % state exam result/final grade in either Biology, Chemistry or Physics; 20% motivation letter.
- Tuition fee: 5000 EUR/year
- Tuition-waiver scholarships

Medicine

The programme is designed to teach students the core competencies required to become highly skilled doctors. Graduates can work as general practitioners.

- **Duration**: 6 years
- **Entry criteria**: 70 % SAT Subject Test in Biology E/M (minimum score 680); 30% Motivation Letter
- Tuition fee: 12 000 EUR/year
- No tuition-waiver scholarships

- **Duration**: 4 years
- **Cost**: No tuition fee
- **Stipend**: doctoral allowance (660€/month), performance stipend (400€/month).

General admission requirements

- Online application (Documents by post upon request)
- Motivation Letter
- Official copy of your previous education
- Application fee 50 EUR
- Proof of English language proficiency (except Medicine)
 - ü TOEFL iBT 75
 - $\ddot{\mathrm{u}}$ IELTS (academic) 5.5 (no part can be below 5.5)

Tuition-waiver scholarships

- For most programmes, except Medicine; and a few other programmes
- Cover the tuition fee for the entire studies
- Must study full-time (60 ECTS per year)
- Automatically considered when you apply for the programme



Monthly stipends for Master's students

- Dora Plus scholarship
 - § 350 EUR/month for 1 academic year
 - § Automatically considered when applying
- Estonian Ministry of Foreign Affairs scholarships
 - § 400 EUR/month for up to 2 academic years
 - § Automatically considered when applying







International summer university

- Various short (up to 3 weeks)
 programmes in the field of Social
 Science, Law, Business, IT, Humanities
- Estonian language courses (based on Finnish or English)
- Tailor-made programmes for partner universities



Free online courses

- Short e-courses open to everybody
- Both in Estonian and English
- Example of courses:

 Estimation of Measurement
 Uncertainty in Chemical
 Anayses (e-course of the year 2015), Diffusion and Impact of Internet Voting, EU-Russia
 Relations, Digital Image
 Processing, Introduction to Semantics, Energy Policies in Estonia etc.



Exchange opportunities

- Exchange semester at a partner university, and internships abroad
- Over 80 partner universities in 30 countries
- Erasmus + and Dora Plus scholarships







Accommodation

- Appartment-style dormitories
- Two students per room
- Cost: up to 150 €/month
- Wifi, bike parking, laundry, common area
- 5 mins walk to Tartu's main square, 10 mins to the University of Tartu main building







Cost of living
